

Environmental General Information

Post-consumer material is defined as material generated by households or by commercial, industrial and institutional facilities in the role as end-users of the product, which can no longer be used for its intended purpose.

Pre-consumer material is defined as material diverted from the waste stream during the manufacturing process.

Excluded is reutilization of materials such as a rework, regrind or scrap generated in a process and capable of being reclaimed within the same process that generated it.

Powder Coat Paint: Contains no lead OR solvents and as a result releases no Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC's).

Packaging: Contains 20% post-consumer recycled content.

Rapidly Renewable Materials-Steel Products: Steel by its nature is highly recyclable but is not rapidly renewable.
